Guidelines for Musical Talent Fest for Parish Choir/Members

You need to register online https://forms.gle/KPKgWcKLiSBVeewD6 Register before 10/07/20 Submit your entries before 10/09/20.

Lyrics will be in Malayalam and will be provided to the registered team.

You need to tune the song. The tune should be original; No parody is allowed. You have the freedom to hire a music composer for the above purpose but you will have to provide a statutory declaration/ Notary attestation or equivalent by the composer to affirm the genuineness and consent to publish.

You can have your own orchestration or hire a recorded orchestration.

Singers should be the members of the parish/mission. This has to be attested by your parish priest. There is no restriction for the number of teams participating from a parish.

A team should consist a minimum of 4 members, no maximum number.

A recorded copy of the master Audio & or a video of the song with sufficient audio quality need to be submitted.

Visuals of the video can be edited and enhanced. Kindly follow the social distancing laws in your state at the time of recording. Otherwise it might not be possible to publish.

The consent form needs to be filled in and sent by the team for each one appearing in the video frame.

A template will be provided after the registration:

- statutory declaration/ Notary attestation or equivalent by the composer.
- Attestation by parish priest.
- List and consent of persons appearing in the video frame

Submission of your entry will entitle the Eparchy and Department of Catechesis to publish your song in a public forum. The shares and likes in our FB page matters to carry it to the final evaluation desk by the professionals.
