

Academic Tenure

Minor Seminary: Three year course. one year of initiation into the seminary and spiritual life and two year Higher Secondary course and spiritual formation. Three year Tertiary course of Bachelor degree in any subject. Major Seminary formation includes two year course on philosophical subjects and four year course on Theological subjects.

The Spiritual Benefits of Sponsors

Everyday seminarians will be praying for you and your family. Our Eparchy prays for the benefactors regularly. A Holy Qurbana been offered for benefactors in parishes and missions of our Eparchy every year. The priests of the Eparchy offer one Holy Qurbana every year for the benefactors.

The Expenses for Seminarians

We spend per year, (as of last year), more than Rs. 100,000.00 (One Lakh) towards the expenses of one seminarian for his boarding, lodging, travel, personal expenses, tuition fees and medical expenses. These costs are met with the partial support of sponsors. The amount would usually increase by 15-20% yearly due to inflation.

The Obligations of Sponsors

Daily, or whenever possible, pray for our seminarians. Regular offerings be made towards the support of seminarians as agreed in the beginning. The amount could be given either monthly or quarterly or annually. Make a one-off donation.

A Profile of St. John Paul II Minor Seminary

Since the inauguration of the Eparchy of St.Thomas the Apostle Melbourne in 2014, one of the major goals was to provide priests for pastoral care across communities in Australia.

Our Eparchy started the St. John Paul II Minor Seminary in a rented facility at Pazhayannur, in Thrissur, Kerala on 18 June 2016. Rev. Dr. Lawrence Thaikattil, was appointed the Rector of the Seminary. Due to the inconvenience of the location at Pazhayannur, the seminary was shifted to Thirumudikunnu, Koratty, Kerala, on 30 November 2016, a rented building belonging to the Sisters of Sacred Science. Currently 23 Seminarians in various levels are undergoing formation in different seminaries in Kerala and in Rome.

The St. John Paul II Minor Seminary is the house of formation for the candidates who are aspiring in their journey to priesthood, to be shepherds. The candidates are given initial spiritual orientation and formation to enable them to discern God's plan in their lives, and prepare them to be priests in the Australian Syro-Malabar Church.

These seminarians will be the future priests of the Syro-Malabar Eparchy in Australia who will shepherd you and your children for all pastoral and sacramental needs. It would be a holy endeavour to be part of the priestly formation of our Eparchy. In the initial stage a good number of eparchies in Kerala had shown generosity towards our Seminary. But we cannot expect any more financial support from Kerala or elsewhere for the priestly formation of our seminarians.



By the grace of God, we still get vocations from Kerala. We need to encourage our youth in Australia to priestly vocations. At present, our Eparchy undergoes many initial difficulties such as scarcity of priests and finance as well. Yet we are hopeful that God will inspire many of our young people to accept His call to priesthood and our faithful to support with generosity this divine plan through prayer and financial help.
